The pair's aim was to provide a personal and professional service to accident victims, and their clients include families of victims of fatal accidents and serious injuries.

They pride themselves on never having paid for or bought any cases and instead all work is received through recommendations with lawyers visiting clients at home or hospital if needed.

Since it was set up, just over four years ago, the firm has expanded rapidly to a staff of eight and has recently relocated to premises in New Walk, in Leicester.

and makes donations to Prostaïd, Loros, Rainbows and a local school.

Nicola is heavily involved in supporting De Montfort University and its law students.

She attends its legal law clinic and Meet The Practitioner evenings and the firm mentors two or three of the university's students each year.
